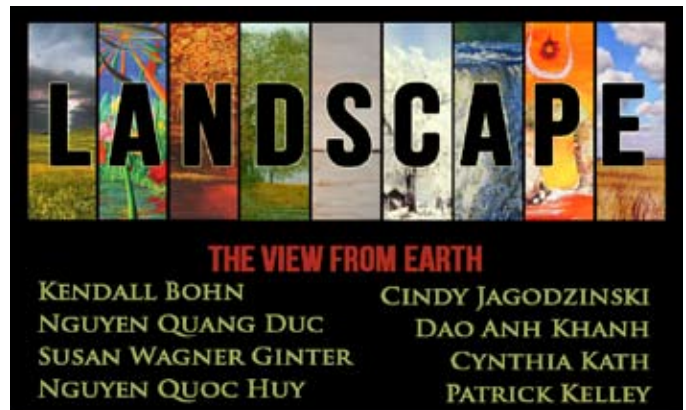

Informational and Technical Sessions will be combined in three separate sessions throughout Minnesota. These sessions are conducted by Program Director, Scott Stulen and Program Assistant, Jehra Patrick. The first half of each presentation will inform potential applicants about the history of the fellowship program, crafting proposals, fellowship eligibility requirements, and the format of the second round of panel reviews. The second half of each session will include information on the online submission process and feature demonstrations on how to format and prepare application materials.
